COURSE SYLLABUS

I. Course Catalog Description

Learners engage in two projects that assess their achievements and preparation for pursuit of professional aspirations in their major field. Through application and assessment, learners examine the knowledge and skills gained throughout the program, achievement of the program outcomes, and their preparation as followers and leaders in their chosen professional field. *Prerequisites: All major courses.*

II. Required and Supplementary Instructional Materials

There is no required textbook for this course. The required materials and documents will either be posted in the Bb course or come from learners' prior work products from their major program. The class will also feature live instruction in the form of <u>required Collaborate sessions</u>.

III. Learning Outcomes

Learning outcomes describe the knowledge, skills, values, and attitudes that learners gain as the result of a particular learning experience. Southwestern College Professional Studies has learning outcomes specific to each program of study that are in line with the institutional outcomes of critical thinking, ethical reasoning, leadership, communication, and career preparation. Course outcomes support program outcomes and are listed below.

Upon successfully completing this course, the learner will be able to:

- 1. Develop a portfolio project that demonstrates the knowledge, skills, and abilities gained in the major discipline.
- 2. Present evidence and artifacts from the major courses to document achievement of specific program outcomes.
- 3. Describe the different types of followership and leadership styles and traits.
- 4. Determine desirable followership and leadership styles and traits for the expected professional field and role.
- 5. Evaluate one's own strengths and areas for improvement in followership and leadership.
- 6. Create a followership and leadership development plan.

At the end of the course, learners may vary in their ability to achieve these outcomes. You are more likely to achieve these outcomes only if you attend class and/or online activities as required by the syllabus, complete the requirements for all assignments to the best of your ability, participate actively in class activities and group work as directed, and study diligently for exams.
