- 7. Demonstrate critical thinking and ethical reasoning through effective research, analysis, application, and communication activities required for leading, planning, managing, and using an HRIS.

At the end of the course, learners may vary in their ability to achieve these outcomes. You are more likely to achieve these outcomes only if you attend class and/or online activities as required by the syllabus, complete the requirements for all assignments to the best of your ability, participate actively in class activities and group work as directed, and study diligently for exams.
