Program Description

The Southwestern College Professional Studies Graduate Certificate in Executive Accounting provides an opportunity for graduate learners to add an area of emphasis to their non-accounting business degrees. Learners pursuing the Master of Accountancy graduate degree could also earn the certificate to demonstrate a progression of success in their program. The courses emphasize awareness of multiple types of organizations that rely on ethical accounting practices along with planning and decision-making based on various financial and non-financial transactions. Learners examine the integration of accounting reporting systems into business processes and develop skills to evaluate computerized accounting methods and controls.

Admission Requirements

Anyone interested in completing the Executive Accounting Certificate may complete a Southwestern College Professional Studies Graduate Application for Admission and provide their transcript from a regionally accredited institution listing their completed Bachelor's degree. The five courses comprising the Executive Accounting Certificate can be completed in eight months or less in convenient 6-week classes.

Individuals completing the Executive Accounting Certificate at Southwestern College may apply all of these 15 credit hours earned toward a Master of Accountancy degree or a portion of the credit hours towards a Master of Business Administration or a Master of Science in Management.
