## Information Technology and Cyber Crime Certification Training

The Center for Corporate Learning offers a variety of industry certification preparation courses that will help industry personnel obtain the credentials considered to be in high demand throughout the Defense, Intelligence and IT industries. As part of Southwestern College's continuing commitment to offer education and training to the government's workforce, Southwestern College offers the following Information Technology certification training courses in support of the Department of Defense Directive 8570.1.

DoD Directive 8570.1 mandates that all full or part-time service members, defense contractors, and DoD civilian employees with access to a DoD information system, are required to possess a commercial information security credential endorsed by ANSI or equivalent authorized body under the ANSI/ISO/IEC 17024 Standard.

There are various levels of compliance based on the level of job function. The most common certifications included in the DoD Directive 8570.01 include A+, Network+, Security+, CISA, CISM, CASP, CEH and CISSP.
