Southwestern College Professional Studies is committed to providing adult learners with accessible, high-quality education that helps them achieve their personal, professional and academic goals. The New Builder Scholarship is designed to support new learners in pursuing these goals by investing in motivated adult learners and helping them build a strong foundation for their educational journey.

Scholarship Eligibility and Requirements

- Learners must be seeking their **first** baccalaureate degree.
- Learners must be a new student to Southwestern College, complete all admission requirements and be admitted to Southwestern College Professional Studies.
- Learners must submit a completed New Builder Scholarship application, a typed one page personal statement of 500-750 words and unofficial transcripts from all previously attended colleges. The Personal statement should address the learner's long term goals, why they would like this scholarship, financial need and/or any additional information the scholarship committee should consider.
- The New Builder Scholarship will cover the tuition and technology fees for up to 4 credit hours (excluding books) and is applicable only to the **first** session of enrollment at Southwestern College.
- The New Builder Scholarship award is non-renewable and is awarded to a learner only once.
- The New Builder Scholarship is only available Fall and Spring semester sessions.
- Learners who are eligible for tuition assistance from an employer, Military Tuition Assistance, VA Education Benefits or another organization (excluding federal financial aid) are not eligible to receive this scholarship.
