

T-Mobile Onsite Classes Frequently Asked Questions

Will this course help me complete a degree?

- Yes. Ethics is a Foundation course for every degree at Southwestern College. It is also a common general education requirement at other colleges and universities.

Are courses from your institution accredited?

- Yes. Southwestern College is accredited by the Higher Learning Commission (HLC). The HLC is one of six regional institutional accreditors serving the North Central region of the United States.

Do I need to be in a degree program to take this course?

- No. While this course will transfer well into many degree programs, you do not need to be a degree seeking student to take this course.

What if I want to continue courses?

How much time should I plan to study outside of class?

- This obviously varies per student, but we have found most students typically spend about 12-15 hours per weeks on their studies.

I have been out of school for an extended period of time, are there any resources available to me to aid me in the transition?

- Yes. All students attending Southwestern College are paired with an Academic Success Coach. This person is there to answer any questions you might have about the process of obtaining a degree. Additionally, we have resources like an Online Writing Center that can help you brush up on your writing skills if you are a little rusty.

How do I enroll in the course?

- For now, you will just fill out the interest form until we determine how many how many people would like to take the course. If that number is greater than the number of spots available in the course, a lottery will be held by T-Mobile to determine who get to take the course. At that point, all students selected will be contacted and walked through the enrollment process.

What materials are required to take the course? What should I bring to the course with me?

- Ethics requires a book that is available in either print or electronic form. You should bring your copy of the book, as well as a notebook or laptop to take notes with.

Is there a special rate for T-Mobile employees?

- Yes, Southwestern has agreed to cap tuition for T-Mobile employees at the amount full-time employees are allotted per year (currently \$5250). This does not include books or fees, so if you continue past your maximum, you will still be personally responsible for the cost of any books or fees associated with the courses.
