Learners will also analyze mitigation measures from an enterprise level perspective. Our program is aligned with academic and industry wide technical competencies illustrated in American Society for Industrial Security (ASIS's) Enterprise Security Model.

Admission Requirements

Anyone interested in completing the Certificate in Cybercrime Investigation may complete a Southwestern College Professional Studies Application for Admission. The five courses comprising the Cybercrime Investigation Certificate can be completed in eight months or less and there are no prerequisites.

Individuals completing the Cybercrime Investigation Certificate at Southwestern College may apply these 15 multi-discipline credit hours toward any bachelor's degree offered by Southwestern College Professional Studies as either a major requirement or an elective.
