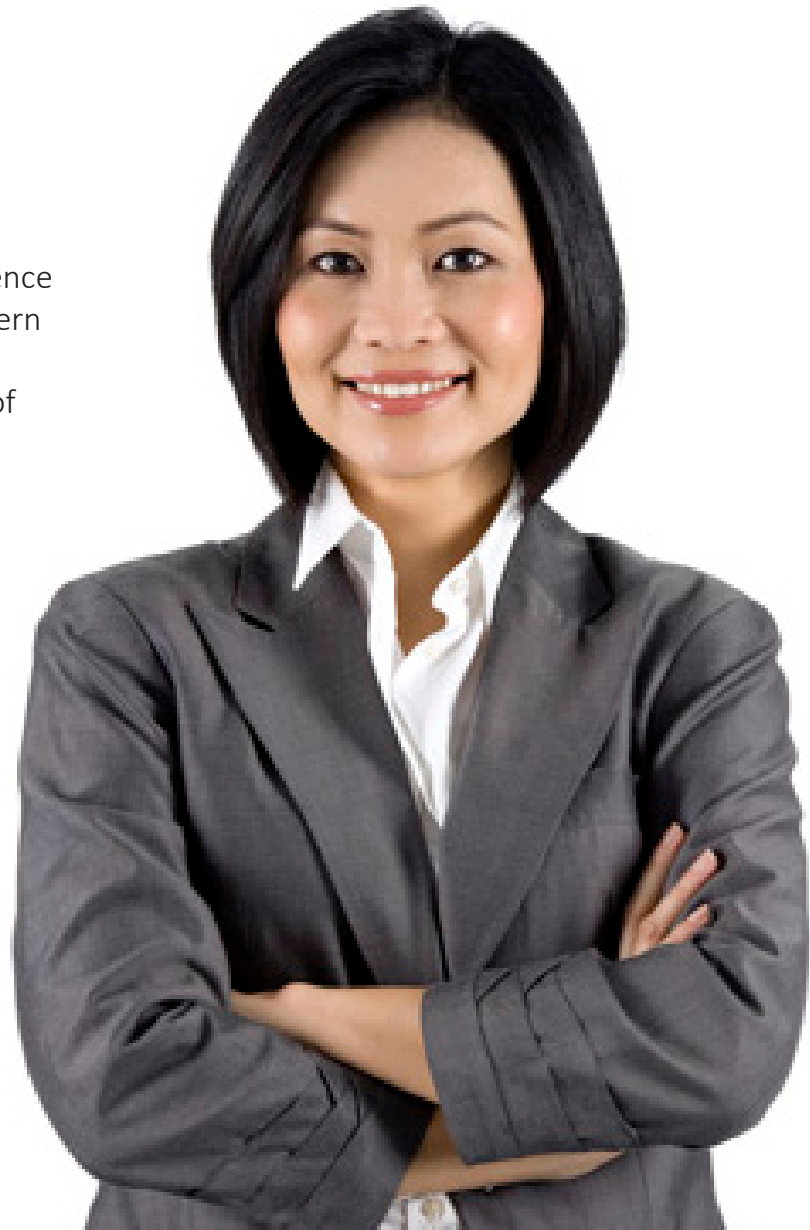

## Graduation Requirements

1. Complete the specific program requirements for the master's program
2. Have an overall grade point average of 3.0, with no grade below a C (2.0)
3. Complete a minimum of 36 credit hours

## Program Description

The Master of Education in Special Education High-Incidence Disabilities at Southwestern College is designed for those who wish to earn an endorsement in teaching special education as part of their graduate degree. A minimum of 36 credit hours are required for the graduate degree. An endorsement in high incidence disabilities may be earned in 33 credit hours. A minimum of nine credit hours is required for a provisional endorsement. EDUC 512 Action Research must be completed within the first 15 credit hours of the program of study.

## Admission Process

1. Complete graduate application forms
2. Provide current resume
3. Submit two professional letters of recommendation (at least one from a current or former employer)
4. Turn in one-page personal essay
5. Submit official transcript from the bachelor's degree-granting institution.
6. Be a current, licensed teacher and provide a copy of your teaching license
